Overlooking the Cher Valley, our family-run estate is closely linked to the history of the Château de Fontenay, where wines have been grown since the 13th Century. The names of our wines are inspired by its history and our children, who are writing the next chapter.

Located in the Touraine Loire Valley, this terroir has calcareous-clay and flinty-clay soils. These exceptional conditions naturally contribute to creating high quality wines with particularly rich aromatic and structured complexity and enable a wide range of grape varieties :

Whites : Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Chenin

Reds : Gamay, Cabernet Franc, Côt (Malbec)

Rosé : Grolleau, Cabernet Franc, Côt

What makes us unique :

- Our estate produces Touraine Chenonceaux and Touraine AOP wines, perfect for the English palate.
- Our estate is certified HVE3 (High Environmental Value), the highest level of overall environmental certification recognising biodiversity, flora protection, management of fertiliser use and water use.
- We are an independent family winemaker, passionate about producing unique and exceptional quality wines. 15 hectares of vineyard.
- We sell our wines to wine merchants in France but also directly at the Château and on most French regional wine fairs. We have face to face communication with our clients.
- We export to U.S.A, Germany, Romania, The Netherlands, Belgium, New Caledonia, China.
